Seek no more, because **Gobustan Historical-Artistic Preserve** is exactly what you need! Included in the UNESCO heritage list, being one of the first centers of human civilization, Gobustan can offer its guests **6000 ancient drawings**—petroglyphs on the walls & caves, rocks & boulders related to the Upper Paleolithic period. Beside, you can visit **Gobustan Museum** offering guests innovative technology touch screens with special interactive displays & 3D videos.

Afterwards, you will see a fasinating **Heydar Aliyev Centre** which was designed by famous architect Zaha Khadid & opened in 2012.

LAND OF FIRE LEGENDS: GALA – ATESHGAH – YANARDAQ

<u>Tour includes:</u> transport, Eng/Rus speaking driver-guide <u>Tour excludes:</u> entrance fees to museums if any Visiting **Gala State Historical Ethnographic Reserve** & **Open Air Museum** to see the original lifestyle of Azerbaijanis dated back to the 10-19th c. In the village there are 243 monuments of architecture and archeology, from the prehistoric man of the Bronze Age (3000 BC.) to the surviving mosques, baths, and premises belonging to the late Middle Ages.

You can try to bake bread in "tandir", weave a carpet, smear with clay in a pottery workshop or feed camels and horses.

Going to **Ateshgah** - an ancient Zoroastrian temple of flame built in the 17-18thc. & **Yanardag** (literary "burning mountain") to observe natural burning flame outlets at the surface. Most probably the fire has been burning for over 20,000 years at Yanardag.

On the way of city center, stop over the building of **Heydar Aliyev Center**, created by world-famous architect Zaha Hadid, for taking photos.
