

PROCEDURE

in case of positive PCR test result on the territory of Azerbaijan

1. Guest is being isolated in the hotel room.
2. Guest, hotel or travel agency (whoever is the first to know about the test result) calls “103” (short phone number for the ambulance) or “9103” (short phone number of the Ministry of Health) and reports the case.
3. Ambulance comes to the hotel to check the condition of the guest.
4. In the serious case guest is being transported to the hospital for treatment at state expense.
5. If guest’s condition is not serious, he is being transported to the special quarantine center (at the “Athletes Village”), where he stays in quarantine for 14 days at state expense. If there is no free rooms in the quarantine center guest is being isolated in a quarantine room at the hotel at the expense of the guest.
6. After 14 days guest undergoes the next PCR test. If result is positive again, the above mentioned procedure is being repeated. If result is negative, guest is free to fly home.
